



## Policy 05 Support for Players Selected for State Representation

### Policy Statement

West Scarborough Junior Rugby Union Club (WSJRUC) is committed to the development and support of our players who achieve selection into representative teams.

### Principles

- WSJRUC recognises the required time, effort and commitment of players to achieve selection into representative teams.
- WSJRUC values all players and is focused on increasing participation in the sport.
- WSJRUC upholds the reputation of our club in providing a positive and safe environment for our players.

### Rationale

This policy is to ensure all players who are selected for representative teams are provided financial support from the club to recognise their sacrifices and commitment to the game.

**WSJRUC** recognises that

- Having players selected in representative teams will have an impact on availability of those players for local competition team matches as well as training.

### Implementation

For WSJRUC players who are selected for representative teams to be eligible for WSJRUC funding they must .:

- Be full financial members of the club;
- Have played continuously throughout the season for WSJRUC;
- Have participated actively in at least two fund raising events;
- Be a proactive member of the club by assisting in field set ups and pack downs;
- Provide a positive role model to junior players; and
- Apply to the committee for funding.

## Process for application.

Those seeking financial assistance are to submit a brief application (approx. one A4 page) outlining how they have met the the eligibility criteria listed above.

The committee is to review and consider the application at a committee meeting. An out of session decision may be made provided it is endorsed at the next committee meeting.

The Committee will determine the value of the contribution with a minimum of \$150 and a maximum of \$500 depending on the involvement the player has had in contributing to general fundraising for WSJRUC.

This funding is to be provided directly to Rugby WA, not to the player themselves, to cover the player contribution to Rugby WA and to limit any debt being incurred.

## Promoting this policy

WSJRUC will:

- Advise players of the availability of support to representative players during preseason and throughout the season in the club newsletters and social media posts.
- Place a copy of this policy on the Club's website.

## Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure it remains relevant to club operations and reflects both community expectations and legal requirements.
